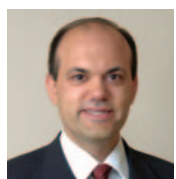


Twelve-year-old Eric Garza has played roller and ice hockey for the past eight years.

Swift Action for a Complex Injury

After arriving at Riverview, the Emergency Department staff wasted no time. **Nader Bakhos, M.D.**, an orthopedic surgeon on staff at Riverview, met with Eric and called for an X-ray.

"Eric sustained an open fracture in his left arm," Dr. Bakhos says. "I could tell he was in a lot of pain, but he was brave through the whole process." As a hockey player, the bumps and bruises Eric has experienced on the ice rink have made him one tough nut to crack.

Despite Eric's composure, Dr. Bakhos knew time was of the essence. "It was a severe fracture. If we didn't act quickly enough, things could easily go from bad to worse." According to Dr. Bakhos, an open fracture is one in which the bone has pierced the skin, which makes the body incredibly vulnerable to infection if left untreated.
